



Level 1 Food Safety for Manufacturing – Training Course

COURSE OVERVIEW:

The Level 1 Award in Food Safety for Manufacturing is intended for learners working in a manufacturing environment and those who are preparing to work in the industry. Learners gaining this course will know that food safety is the responsibility of everyone involved in the storage, preparation, processing, packing and handling of food.

The subjects covered are regarded by the Foods Standards Agency as being important to ensure good practice and the production of safe food.

COURSE ASSESSMENT:

This qualification is assessed through a 15-question multiple-choice question examination. The duration of the examination is 30 minutes. Successful learners must achieve a score of at least 10 out of 15.

Following the assessment, a list of results will be provided to the Centre Contacts stating whether learners have passed or failed. Certificates for successful learners will be dispatched for distribution by the Centre Contacts.
