Master in Business Administration (MBA) Hospital Management Major

This accredited MBA applies to all graduates from different disciplines provided that they are in compliance with the admission requirements set by GSB for all applicants to the MBA degree.

Duration: 2 years, 4 semesters, 6 months each semester.

Number of courses: The degree consists of 16 courses, 4 courses each semester.

Classes are Conducted: Either weekdays twice a week from 6:00 pm – 10:00 pm **Or** weekends every other week (Friday from 9:00 am - 6:00 pm) (Saturday from 10:00 am - 6:00 pm).

Starting Date for Program:-

2 Intakes per year (May / October).

Admission:

➤ Admission requirements:-

1. Original bachelor degree minimum grade good & original transcript.
2. Accreditation from the High Supreme Council of Universities for non-Egyptians and private universities.
3. 4 photos & ID copy / passport copy.
4. Advanced Management Admission Test (AMAT) Exam will be held in the GSB.
5. TOEFL Score Inst. (500), International (79) or IELTS Score (6) or a local TOEFL exam held in the GSB.
6. Passing interview.
7. Upon applying applicants should not be enrolled in any post-graduate studies inside or outside the Academy.

- Passing (16 Course) 48 credit hours.
- Obtaining at least GPA 3.0 out of 4.0
- Passing the comprehensive exam at the end of the 4th semester.
- Clearing financial & administrative commitments.
- Handing back the collage ID to student's affairs.

Hospital Management Major:

Hospitals and other health services centers are complex operations, which require capable managers to oversee their many departments and affairs. Generally, students interested in becoming a hospital manager earn a degree in health administration. While degrees are available at the bachelor's level, a master's degree is typically required for administrative positions at this level

After passing the 8 core courses of the first and second semester and obtaining at least GPA 3.0 out of 4.0, students will study a specialization Major (Hospital Management) offered in the third and fourth semester's courses "4 courses per semester" followed by the comprehensive exam.
